

ISA Board Teleconference

March 1, 2010

ISA has been contacted by Offender Watch about an opportunity to have the system statewide and paid for by the US Marshal's Service. They are asking for a letter of support from ISA by March 3, 2010. The program is used to track sex offenders and send notifications to law enforcement and citizens that ask for the service. ISP will work with us if this is something that we want to do. Offender Watch also has a mapping function. Canyon County is currently looking at this program and it would cost them about \$1,600 per month. The only other concern is if using this system would require dual entry of sex offenders by our staff. ISP, Dawn Peck, has said that if we get this system that they will work with it and not require dual entry. Motion to send a support letter made by Sheriff Raney second by Sheriff Smith, motion passed.
